Robert Esche is the CEO of Mohawk Valley Garden, which encompasses the American Hockey League’s Utica Comets, Utica City FC, ORB Food and Beverage, and Garden Entertainment. Esche also works with local community leaders to continue to grow the Adirondack Bank Center and additional sporting/entertainment ventures throughout the Mohawk Valley, including the addition of the Nexus Center.

Esche’s experience with the AHL started in 1998, first playing for the Springfield Falcons. He then moved on to the Phoenix Coyotes, then the Philadelphia Flyers. In 2003, he won the prestigious William M. Jennings Trophy, and in 2004 he represented the United States at the World Cup of Hockey. He completed his professional career with teams in Russia and Switzerland.
